# Overcoming Fears, Enduring Discomfort through Hope



Tepeth young men keenly evaluate us as we approach their village. A similar spiritual community has been birthed on Mt. Napak. Seven years ago, our pastor from Good Shepherd Community Church in Boring, came to serve with us, together with his daughter and others. At the end of his ministry, we decided to take a climb up Mt. Napak, where an unreached people group, the Tepeth. lived. There were a few tribulations on the way. After conquering the muddy roads, we were climbing up the slippery paths, when we startled a herd of wild pigs and threw them into a phrenzy, resulting in the lead boar stampeding down the hill towards Val. If swine could be bowling balls, this one was

aiming for a strike! Val narrowly escaped, as it charged between her legs, while those behind her were tackled and sent tumbling off the path!

Regrouping, wiping off mud and blood, we continued the trek to the Tepeth villages. A few hundred meters higher, we noticed several tribal lookouts perched behind trees, with their machine guns and arrows ready. As a warring tribe, they can expect

confrontations and are always ready to defend themselves. A few kind words and introductions helped them to recognize allowed to pass.
